Plans for traffic on Hollow Way. As you may have heard, Oxfordshire County Council is proposing to put in six traffic filters in Oxford next year with the idea of reducing traffic, making walking and cycling safer and making bus journeys faster. When they are operating, private cars will not be allowed through the traffic filters without a permit. One of these filters is proposed for the top of Hollow Way. It will operate from 7am to 7pm., Monday-Saturday. While this will not affect us on Sunday mornings, it will hinder people coming to Mass during the week and on Saturday evenings.
