I recall with gratitude the warmth and impact of Pope Benedict's presence during his State Visit in

2010 and especially during his visit to Birmingham for the Beatification of Cardinal Newman. He showed us the love of the pastor's heart which had guided his ministry as priest, as bishop and as Supreme Pastor. I am grateful for the prayerful way that he supported his successor Pope Francis, continuing to promote the unity and mission of the Church. On behalf of the clergy, Religious and all the faithful of the Archdiocese of Birmingham I offer our condolences and pray that Emeritus Pope Benedict may rest in peace with his risen Lord."


