Welcome to Our Lady Help of Christians for our celebration of Mass. Today we begin Holy Week.

Holy Week is the greatest week in the Church's year, so please take part as much as you can. By taking part in the celebrations of the Liturgy we can enter into the events that happened about two thousand years ago. But we enter in, not as bystanders or casual observers but as believers, recognising our own part in what is unfolding, and also recognising the great things that God has done for us. We can share with Jesus His triumphant entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, His special celebration of the Passover with His disciples at the Last Supper and then His agony and betrayal in the Garden on Maundy Thursday, all the horrible events of Good Friday, His "Sabbath Rest" on Holy Saturday, and thus we can truly share in His Resurrection on Easter Sunday.

Wednesday: The Chrism Mass. The Archbishop will celebrate the Chrism Mass at 11.30 on Wednesday morning in St. Chad's Cathedral. The Chrism Mass is the occasion when the Holy Oils are blessed which are used for all Baptisms, Confirmations, Ordinations, and Anointings of the Sick in the diocese during the coming year. It is also the occasion when the priests of the diocese renew their commitment of service to God and the Church.

Maundy Thursday: The Mass of the Lord's Supper at



7.00 pm on Maundy Thursday evening is the end of Lent and the start of the Easter Triduum. At this Mass we celebrate the institution of the Sacraments of the Eucharist and the Priesthood.

Watching at the Altar of Repose. When the Mass of the Last Supper ends we shall go to the Altar of Repose and keep watch with Jesus, remembering His Agony in the Garden and His acceptance of His Father's will.

Good Friday: On Good Friday there is no Mass, but at 3.00 pm in the afternoon, the hour at which our Lord



died, there is a "Solemn Celebration" of the Passion of our Lord. There are four parts:

- 1. The Introductory Rites
- 2. The Liturgy of the Word
- 3. The Veneration of the Cross
- 4. Holy Communion

Holy Saturday: We do not celebrate Mass on Holy Saturday, the Lord's Day of Rest in the tomb, but in the evening at 8.00 pm we begin our Easter celebrations with the Easter Vigil, the greatest event in the Church's year. This year we celebrate with Raymond Clement as he is baptised and becomes a child of God. There are four parts to the service:

- 1. The Service of Light
- 2. The Liturgy of the Word
- 3. The Liturgy of Baptism
- 4. The Liturgy of the Eucharist

Here is an Act of Spiritual Communion:

"My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You."

The collection on Good Friday is for the Holy Places – i.e. for the upkeep of the sites in the Holy Land associated with the life of Our Lord.

Traditionally the collection at the Easter Masses is your personal offering to your priest. There are envelopes at the back of church if you wish. Thank you.

Easter Triduum. There is a list on the table at the back of church for people to sign up for various roles at the services of Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday. Please don't be shy.

Easter Flowers. There will be a retiring collection today towards the cost of the flowers that will adorn our church for the coming celebration of Easter.

Holy Week for Altar Servers. There will be training for the servers on "Spy" Wednesday (5th April):

- For Maundy Thursday, the rehearsal is at 5.00 pm.
- For Good Friday, the rehearsal will be at 5.30 pm.
- For the Easter Vigil the rehearsal will be at 6.00 pm.

The Sacrament of Confirmation. Tuesday, 30th May, at 6.00 pm. Lessons will be starting after Easter. Apply at www.olhoccowley.co.uk/sacraments/confirmation or fill in an application form at the back of church.
