World Youth Day, Lisbon 2023. Although it is called a "Day" this adventure of a lifetime for some of the young people of our Diocese and young people from all around the world really lasts for several days. There have been many events going on but the main ones have been an opening Mass last Tuesday, celebrated by the Cardinal Patriarch of Lisbon. Last Thursday there was the welcoming ceremony, the first meeting of the young people with the Pope, and on Friday evening there was a celebration of Stations of the Cross. This weekend, on Saturday night there is a Vigil, starting at 8.45 pm, with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and prayer. The climax of the week is the Missioning Mass at 9.00 on Sunday morning, celebrated by the Pope.
