Work on the church floor has gone well this week, thank God, and it should be finished soon.

After the benches had been taken into the Don Bosco Centre both the size of the floor and the poor state of it became apparent.



The first task was to find and re-fix any wood blocks that had become unstuck (which proved to be quite a lot).

Then the sanding of the floor could start. It was noisy, but with four big machines it didn't take as long as you might think.
