- Parish Memorial Mass for those in the parish who have died, especially those whose funerals have been held here during the past year, on Saturday, 23rd November, 11.00 am. If you would like anyone's name to be included, please let me know.
- Remembrance Sunday, 10th November. We • shall have a short service after each Mass to pray for those who have died in war and for peace.

Fire Safety. For some time I have been thinking that safety procedures in the case of a fire in the church are not at all clear. When we have a trained team we can have a fire drill. Would you consider being one of the team of fire stewards, please? There will be suitable training.
